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PT1158 Private tour Croatia with wine experience Zagreb – Rovinj – Zadar – Split – Dubrovnik 9 nights / 10 days 2017

SUGGESTED ITINERARY:

DAY 1

Arrival to Zagreb airport.
Transfer from the airport to the hotel.
Overnight at the hotel in Zagreb area.

DAY 2

Breakfast at the hotel.

Zagreb sightseeing tour with local guide (duration; approx. 2,5 hrs)

Zagreb grew up on two neighbouring hills: Kaptol - the centre of spiritual and religious life of north-western Croatia and Gradec - the commercial centre of skilful tradesmen and craftsmen. Visit the Upper Town with its Gothic Cathedral, the beautiful and ornate St. Catherine's church or the massive St. Mark's church with its famous colour-tiled roof. Continue to the medieval Stone Gate and "Dolac", the open-air market which are a must for all visitors.

Rest of the day at leisure.
Overnight at the hotel in Zagreb area.

DAY 3

Breakfast at the hotel.
Transfer from Zagreb to Rovinj (Duration approx. 6 hrs)

*Istria is one of the best know regions for wine production in Croatia.
On the way from Zagreb to Rovinj stop for wine tasting will be arranged.*

Overnight at the hotel in Rovinj area.

DAY 4

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full day Istria tour excursion with local guide (duration: approx. 9 hrs)

Go back in history and visit one the most significant tourist region in Croatia and it's beautiful towns; Rovinj – a typical medieval Venetian town, distinctive for its romantic narrow little streets and the imposing church of its patron saint, St. Euphemia; Porec – an ancient town known for its masterpieces of Byzantine sacral art, the Euphrasius Basilica dating from the 6th century; and Pula – an ancient town with its well-preserved amphitheatre.

Overnight at the hotel in Rovinj area.



DAY 5

Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer from Rovinj to Plitvice (duration approx. 5 hrs)

Visit of the Plitvice National Park with local guide (duration approx. 3hrs)

Plitvice National Park is one of the most beautiful and best preserved national parks in the country. This is why the entire lakes and surrounding area were declared a national park in 1949 and are listed on the UNESCO's list of World Heritage Sites because of its exceptional beauty. It is a valley situated between high forested mountains in which lie, one below another, a string of sixteen beautiful lakes of crystal blue and green waters. Fed by small streams and brooks, they spill into each other in 92 foaming cascades and thundering waterfalls. The Plitvice lakes' scenery will simply delight you regardless whether you are walking the paths and wooden bridges, taking a boat ride or just taking photographs.

Transfer continues to Zadar (duration approx. 3 hrs).

Overnight at the hotel in Zadar area.

DAY 6

Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer from Zadar to Split (Duration approx. 3 hrs)

On the way a stop will be made in Primosten area for wine tasting.

The area is the home of Croatia's most famous red wine Babić.

Split sightseeing tour with local guide (duration approx. 2hrs)

The Split private tour will take you along the Old City to visit main sights: the old town of Split is built on and around the spectacular Roman Palace erected by the Roman Emperor Diocletian (born in Salona – today's Solin) in the 4th century. The walking tour starts with a visit to the cellars of the Palace that are still very well preserved. The cellars offer a good view at how the life in the Palace was organized. Other sites will be seen along the way.

Overnight at the hotel in Split area.

DAY 7

Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer from Split to Dubrovnik (duration approx. 4 hrs) via Ston

Ston is a small town on a narrow isthmus connecting the peninsula of Pelješac with the mainland. The area is known for salt production, high quality oysters/mussels and wine production. Stop to taste locally produced wine.

Overnight at the hotel in Dubrovnik area.

DAY 8

Breakfast at the hotel.

Dubrovnik sightseeing tour with local guide (duration approx. 2 hrs)

«... those who seek paradise on Earth should come to Dubrovnik» (George Bernard Shaw)

This tour will reveal the finest sites of the old walled City. The walking tour includes visits to the Dominican Monastery with its fine collection of medieval paintings. Our guide will lead you through the narrow streets of the Old Town introducing you to the history and culture of this magnificent city. Other buildings will be viewed along the way.

Rest of the day at leisure to explore the town on your own.

Overnight at the hotel in Dubrovnik area.



DAY 9

Breakfast at the hotel.

Cavtat and wine tasting in Konavle region (duration approx. 4hrs)

Cavtat – resort situated south from Dubrovnik, the seat of the Konavle County, known by the natural beauty, cultural and folk tradition. This was once Greek settlement Epidaurum, since the year 228 BC an important trade and the Roman Harbour. Cavtat is the birthplace of numerous navigators, ship builders, ship owners and cultural workers. After an orientation tour, continue to Konavle Valley. The most fertile part of the area, known for its wine production. Visit of local winery for wine tasting.

Transfer from the hotel to the Dubrovnik airport.
